

FsfPay Magento 2 Extension

Installation Instructions

Installing the Module:

1. Download the Magento Module from your download link
2. Upload the app.zip file to the server magento root directory
3. SSH into the Server
4. Navigate to the Magneto installation folder
5. Navigate to: `app/code`
6. Make the sure you have a W3ctrl folder under the `app/code`
7. Change into the directory W3ctrl
8. Make the sure you have a folders `Fsfpay` under the `app/code/W3ctrl`
9. Navigate to the root of the Magento Installation folder
10. Enable the module by running `php bin/magento module:enable W3ctrl Fsfpay`
11. Apply database updates by running `php bin/magento setup:upgrade`
12. Flush the cache by running `php bin/magento cache:flush`
13. Done

Your `Fsfpay` Magento Module is now installed. Please continue with the Configuration Instructions, next.

Configuring the Module:

Part 1 - Retrieving Credentials from the Fsfpay Developer Console

1. Navigate to the Fsfpay Developer Console:
`https://panel.fsfpay.com/login`
2. Log in with your Account
3. Navigate to the Merchant details tab:
`https://panel.fsfpay.com/profile/merchant`
4. **Copy the API UserName,API Key and Secret key**

Part 2 - Setting up Credentials in the Magento Admin Panel

1. Navigate to the Magento Admin Panel URL
2. Log in as an Administrator
3. Navigate to Stores->Configuration
4. Navigate to Sales->Payment Methods
5. Locate the Fsfpay - Crypto Payment Gateway section
6. Perform the following tasks:
 - a. Enable the Module
 - b. Set the title of the Module as you wish it to appear on the Magento Checkout Page
 - c. In the **API Username** field, enter the previously recorded **Merchant API Username**
 - d. In the **API Key** field, enter the previously recorded **API Key**
 - e. In the **Secret Key** field, enter the previously recorded **Secret Key**
 - f. For Testing set Test Mode to Yes. In Production set it to No
 - g. For Testing set Debug Mode to Yes. In Production set it to No
 - h. Set the Sort Order for the payment methods you will support on your Magento Checkout Page

7. Save the changes
8. Refresh your Magento Cache
